### NEW EAIP RULES ARE REALLY "PAYING OFF"!

#### Get reimbursed for doing the right thing!

You may be able to access an even greater amount of benefits to assist you in offering transitional work to injured workers. New EAIP rules will make it even more of an incentive to employers to provide transitional work. Through EAIP, you can receive Wage Subsidy, Worksite modification, tools & equipment, clothing and tuition, books, fees, and materials. The new rules are retroactive and can be applied to any eligible claim that hasn't already been submitted for benefits.

Make sure you're utilizing all available EAIP benefits
