Subject: Operating Engineers – Local 701 – January 1, 2017 Wage Increase

The 2015-2019 Operating Engineers Local 701 agreement provides for Group increases as follows:

January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2017

Based on the percentage rate as shown in the consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers (CPI-w) US city average from the third quarter average of 2016, the January 1, 2017 – December 31, 2017 wages will increase per the attached Full Wage Schedule. Fringes for this same period will not change from the previous year and are also shown on the attached Full Wage Schedule.
