**NOTE:**

1. Distributions for the current year are available on AGC website [www.agc-oregon.org](http://www.agc-oregon.org) under **Labor Agreements and Wage Information**.
2. All economic wage adjustments, determined by National CPI-W, will be made from the % difference from the 3rd quarters of the previous two years.  
 Example: 2018 increase – difference between the average of the 3 months of the 3rd quarter of 2017 and the 3 months of the 3rd quarter of 2016. Then divide the difference by the 3rd quarter of 2016 average – change this number to a %. Round to closest one hundredth of a % (2.248% would be 2.25%; 2.222% would be 2.22%)
