This committee monitors and analyzes performance metrics of the chapter's workers' compensation program, in conjunction with representatives with SAIF Corporation and the program contract consultant. Committee members review proposed budgets, plan factors, and select design components to ensure a competitive program offering for members, and provide feedback on marketing and communication strategies to promote participation and growth in the group program.
