






HB 2017: STIP Project Delivery Progress


145 projects varying in size, scope, scale (2018-2027)

Named projects: 10 complete, 6 in construction, 6 planned for construction in 2024/2025.





HB 2017: Project Outcomes 2018-2027



33 replacements513 rehabilitations



Pavement





30 projects funded

11 addressed intersection safety

16 focused on vulnerable users



90+ repaired or replaced

Project Delivery Overview: What's ahead for 2024

- 24-27 STIP Projects 292
 - 137 projects bidding or in construction.
 - 49 projects are HB 2017 funded.
- 27-30 STIP Projects
 - Kicked off planning & scoping.
- Major investments & priority areas
 - Bridges & Seismic
 - ADA curb ramps
 - Safety improvements



Funding Trends: Major Changes in 27-30 STIP

- ~40% reduction in Fix-It funding.
- Doubling of ADA funding, but reduction of nearly 30% of PAT funding.
- Zeroed-out historic discretionary programs, like Enhance and Mass Transit.
 - Reduced other historic discretionary programs, like Elderly and Disabled.
- Even with major reductions, only able to maximize \$70M in unallocated funds already designated to Great Streets 2.0 by OTC.



Projected Outcomes of 27-30 Funds

- Only paving interstates in this timeframe.
- More bridges will be load rated.
- Unable to address remaining bike/walk gaps.
- Significant reduction in asset maintenance and preservation across all modes.
- Reactive vs proactive investments.

- Transition in ODOT construction offices retirements and training.
- Opportunities in the shift to AASHTOWare.
- Weathering the impacts of inflation and other market conditions.
- Delivering on the commitments to our communities – during construction and beyond.
