The Construction Leadership Council began with the vision of becoming the driving force in developing tomorrow's future construction leaders.


In keeping with the group's mission, CLC participants are provided with the following opportunities:

Council Leadership

The Construction Leadership Council is guided by a steering committee which consists of a chair, vice chair, immediate past chair, and 10 members, two of which are filled by AGC student chapter representatives. The chair of the steering committee serves a one-year term. The current chair and steering committee elect a vice chair prior to the opening of the application period. Members of the steering committee may serve a maximum of three consecutive years. The chair of the steering committee sits on the board of directors (BOD) and is expected to attend those meetings to provide council updates and liaison with the CLC and the BOD.
