- *Health & Security is tentatively scheduled to be paid to the NWCT Trust fund for all hours worked through December 31, 2024.
- For Groups, refer to Classifications following Article 32.
- General Foreman: OSHA 30 cert; supervises more than one foreman led crew. Wage rate equal 10% over Journeyman Rate.
- Foreman: Working member that supervises five, (5) or more members. Wage rate equals 8% over Journeyman Rate.
- Carpenter Helper: No H&W contributions for first 250 hours of employment & no pension contribution required for the first 500 hours of employment.
- Welders shall receive a premium of \$1.75 per hour above their Group's journeyman wage rate, with an eight (8) hour minimum.

NOTE:

1. Overtime is calculated on Total Taxable Wage (taxable wage x overtime rate) then taxable deductions (dues and vacation) are deducted.
2. Fringe benefits are to be paid on all hours worked (with the exception of pension for 1st and 2nd term Group 5 apprentices – Article 30) in addition to taxable wages.
3. Apprentices in the 1st and 2nd terms, when working on any State or Federal Prevailing Wage Projects, shall have their Pension Fund contributions paid in full to the managing Trust.
4. Contractors signatory to AGC agreements must pay the Millwright/Pile Driver Industry Fund (Group6) @ \$0.05 per hour

2. All individual 401(k) contributions shall continue to be remitted from June 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024, to the Northwest Carpenters Trust. Starting January 1, 2025, all individual 401(k) contributions shall be remitted to the Southwest Carpenters Administrative Corporation.



Counties Covered: Oregon: Entire State; Washington: Cowlitz, Clark, Klickitat, Skamania, Wahkiakum and 1/2 Pacific

Holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Day after Thanksgiving, Christmas. No work shall be performed on Labor Day except to save life or property.

Main wage table for Carpenter (Group 1). Columns: Classification, Base Pay After Deductions, Vacation, Supp Dues, Total Taxable Wages, Pension, Annuity, Health & Security, Appren, CCCC, CITF, TOTAL PACKAGE. Includes rows for Foreman, Journeyman, and various Apprentices (95% to 60%) with their respective periods.

Main wage table for Carpenter (Group 2). Similar structure to Group 1, including rows for Foreman, Journeyman, and various Apprentices (95% to 60%) with their respective periods.

Main wage table for Bridge & Highway Carpenter (Group 5). Similar structure to previous tables, including rows for Foreman, Journeyman, and various Apprentices (95% to 60%) with their respective periods.

Main wage table for Piledriver (Group 6). Similar structure to previous tables, including rows for Foreman, Journeyman, and various Apprentices (95% to 60%) with their respective periods.

Overtime, Apprenticeship Rates, and Premiums are calculated based on the Total Taxable Wage (Total Taxable Wage x Overtime Rate) then the taxable deductions are (Dues and Vacation) are deducted.

*Health & Security is tentatively scheduled to be paid to the NWCT Trust fund for all hours worked through December 2024.

Dues: The rate for union dues deduction is 4% of the taxable hourly wage rate converted to a cents per hour, times all hours worked. All levels of Carpenters dues deduction are charged using the Journeyman Carpenter wage rate.

AGC Welder Premiums:

Welders shall receive a premium of \$1.75 per hour above their Group's journeyman wage rate, with an eight (8) hour minimum.

Apprentice Carpenters in the 1st and 2nd periods when working on any State or Federal prevailing wage projects shall have their Pension Fund contributions.

Zone Pay: For WA Counties Cowlitz, Wahkiakum and Pacific, the reference city shall be Longview; For Clark and Skamania, the reference city shall be Vancouver or Goldendale.

Table of Reference cities and rates: Zone A (Within 30 Miles, Free Zone), Zone B (>30 and <40 Miles, \$1.25/hour), Zone C (>40 and <50 Miles, \$1.70/hour), Zone D (>50 and <60 Miles, \$2.00/hour), Zone E (>60 and <70 Miles, \$3.00/hour), Zone F (More than 70 Miles, \$5.00/hour), Zone G (More than 100 Miles, \$10.00/hour).

The employer agrees to follow the terms and conditions of the Millwright Employers Association (MEA) Master Labor Agreement for the purposes of performing Millwright work within the states of Oregon and Southwest Washington.

Table for Rate Classes: ORC1 (Oregon & Southwest WA AGC Group 1 Carpenter), ORC2 (Oregon & Southwest WA AGC Group 2 Carpenter), ORCBH (Oregon & Southwest WA AGC Bridge & Hwy Carpenter), ORPD (Oregon & Southwest WA AGC Pile Driver).

Table for Negotiated Increases: January 1, 2025 - Reallocation of H&S Funds; June 1, 2025 - \$4.00 increase to be allocated by the Union; June 1, 2026 - \$3.00 increase to be allocated by the Union. Agreement runs through May 31, 2027.
